- H. Ottley led the review and recommendations for the calendaring of Council and committee activities.
- Confirmed and thanked the 2025 accounting system audit team of Greg Kask and Dick Mehlan.
- Initiated discussion of the Federal and State employment and insurance posters.
- Acknowledged our thanks to T. Stoddert for posting the photos and announcement of our nursery room renovation on Facebook as of this writing this post received 6 comments and 30 Likes!

The Executive Committee also met to:

- Explore how to best manage and report our financial data via QuickBooks; establish our next steps.
- Discuss the deteriorating conditions of the NGH and deck with Properties; begin the process to identify options and info needed to discuss further with the congregation.





Based on the February 2025 financial statement for Pilgrimage United Church of Christ, here are three key highlights:

- 1. **Net Loss of \$2,818.40**—The church experienced a deficit in February, with expenses exceeding income despite supplemental revenue from investments.
- 2. **Strong Investment Returns**—Investment income (\$1,365.56 from dividends and interest) significantly offset the operating deficit, reducing what would have been a \$4,183.96 operational loss.
- 3. **Payroll as Major Expense** Payroll expenses (\$10,659.14) represent approximately 58% of total expenditures, making it by far the largest expense category for the church.
