Jones family (and our Pilgrimage family), the joy of the resurrection celebration of Jesus Christ, and the on-going progress with our Insurance Funds Plans.

And as all of us do our best to support the ministry and mission of this church, we do it looking forward to the renewal of this congregation through our goals for our spiritual growth and the renovation of our sacred spaces.

Your Church Council and Project Champions provided a much welcomed update to our Insurance Funds Plans on March 30th. In addition to being wowed by Lisa Toomey's concepts presentation, we learned about the status of the five approved projects since our January 26th Congregational Meeting:

• Reserve Funds – *complete*.

- Pastor's "True Up" Compensation *Pending*. (Rev. Courtney's Retirement plan application submitted 3-12-2025.)
- Electronic Entrance Sign TBD – need quotes.
- Engagement Programming & Activities TBD: (Awaiting Rev. Jones' return.)
- Real Property Improvements In process:
 (Council approved architect consultant 2/13/2025; RFP input developed at Council Retreat 2/22/2025; NGH Study Project to Executive Committee 3/20/2025; PUCC Facilities Use Questionnaire completed by the committees and church groups in April.)

We are pleased to report that the momentum continued throughout April.

- proved Pastor's retirement plan for 2025 and the first special contribution (True Up Compensation) will be paid by our Treasurer in 2nd quarter.
- April 10th congregation email confirming:
 (Upcoming next steps; pil-grimageuccouncil@gmail.com address for submitting comments & questions; and Lynne's link to her folder on the Pilgrimage website for viewing our various Insurance Funds Plan documents such as Lisa's concept illustrations.)

On April 3rd I called three LED sign companies in Marrietta and obtained commitments from two firms to provide us with their formal quotes no later than June

1st. Another company submitted their equipment proposal on April 18th; as of April 23rd we have two sketches/mockups.

Lisa Toomey is finalizing our RFP (Request for Proposal) for the renovations and has identified architects and potential contractors for Properties to contact for interviews and bids. In other news, your Council continues to make progress in April:

- A Zoom meeting with G. Kask and R. Mehlan on Apr. 3rd with your financial officers to kick off the annual internal audit.
- Stephen Noffke confirmed our credit card application has been approved and the initial cards are issued.
- We obtained signed acknowledgement forms by all lay employees for our new HR Policy.
- Properties seeking quotes for building inspections of the church & NGH.
- Laurie Spenser provided costs for finding leaks in our irrigation system so repairs may be planned.
- Anne Mooney reviewed the Transforming Lives Grant and presented her recommendations.
- Stewardship is organizing efforts to fill Council positions for our June elections.



Based on the March 2025 financial statement for Pilgrimage United Church of Christ, here are three key highlights:

- 1. The church is operating at a deficit of \$4,113 for Q1 2025.
- 2. There are new significant expenses this year, particularly "Pulpit Supply" at \$4,400.
- 3. Our overall financial position remains strong with over \$626,000 in bank accounts and minimal liabilities, despite the current operating deficit.
